**2006 –2007 Homework Policy**

**Purpose:**

In accordance with the Wake County Public School Systems' procedures and regulations, Wake Forest Rolesville High School believes homework to be school related instruction that extends, reinforces and enriches the school experiences outside the classroom.

**Assignments:**

WFRHS teachers shall adhere to our school's homework guidelines regarding the targeted length of time due (no less than the next school/class day) required for completion. The due date of homework assignments should reflect the reasonable time needed for the assignments completion. Any make-up homework assignments because of an excused or unexcused absence(s) will follow the procedures outlined on pages 7 – 8 of the 2006 – 2007 WFRHS Student Agenda.

Some subjects and courses of study may require projects, papers, and other assigned activities used to evaluate students' progress and are not considered homework.

**Specifications:**

- Homework is a teacher assigned activity related to an explained, introduced and guided concept or skill that has clearly defined expectations.
- Homework is specific and within the student's ability.
- Homework is not given as punishment and will not require resources that are not accessible to the student(s).

**Evaluation:**

Feedback on homework is provided in a timely manner and will not exceed 15% of the student's academic grade for the marking period.

A research-based guideline for minutes of homework per day in grades 9 – 12 is 120 minutes per day.
